Fund Auditor Peer Analysis – Global Funds - Growth and Market Share

Best and Worst Performing Peer Groups

- Auditors ranked 11-25 registered the highest growth in funds
 - Funds increased 12.14%, or 1.75x the market
 - Market share increased from 3.46% to 3.63%
 - An increase of 4.85%
- Auditors ranked 1-4 registered the smallest growth in funds
 - Funds increased 3.69%, or 0.53x the market
 - Market share decreased from 25.80% to 25.01%
 - A decrease of 3.05%

Best and Worst Performing Peer Groups

- Auditors ranked 5-10 registered the highest AuA growth
 - AuA increased 25.19%, or 1.18x the market
 - Market share increased from 2.87% to 2.96%
 - An increase of 3.22%
- Auditors ranked >25 registered the lowest AuA growth
 - AuA decreased 4.83%, or -0.23x the market
 - Market share decreased from 0.42% to 0.33%
 - A decrease of 21.53%
